## Senior Expectations

### Senior Ball

- Follow dress code rules posted on the website. Parents will be called to pick up students who are inappropriately dressed, such as revealing clothing, other dress code violations, etc. Leave revealing underclothing at home.
- Students must be sober. If a student or guest attend the Senior Ball under the influence of alcohol or an illegal controlled substance, he or she will be requested to leave the Ball and will be turned over to security. The student will lose his/her graduation ceremony privileges and other senior activities.
- There will be no in and out privileges.

### Senior Picnic

- Only open to P.H. seniors.
- No outside guests allowed.
- Transportation only via school bus; no private vehicles. No exceptions!
- Student may not bring beverages, including bottled water. Only food arranged by Senior Class Advisors will be allowed. No ice chests; back packs will be subject to a search.

### Last Week of School

- Continue to abide by all school rules, policies, and expectations.
- Any suspendable or expellable offenses, including senior pranks, committed the last week of school will result in the loss of privileges including non-participation in the graduation ceremony.

### Graduation Ceremony

- As of May 1, 2008 and forward, any senior with serious disciplinary offenses which result in suspension may lose their senior privileges including walking the stage, Senior Ball, and senior picnic. This includes senior pranks.
- All graduates must wear the school-issued cap and gown to the graduation ceremony.
- Dressy or school clothing must be worn under the gown. No revealing underclothing.
- Caps and gowns may not be decorated or altered in any way.
- Leis must be appropriate and acceptable to school officials (no condom leis); money leis are discouraged.
- It is a policy of the San Jose Event Center to search every graduate for contraband or annoying instruments.
- This means: Do not bring any items to throw or otherwise celebrate with during or after the ceremony or your diploma will be held.
